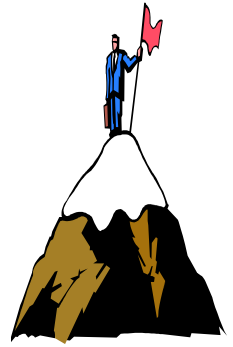

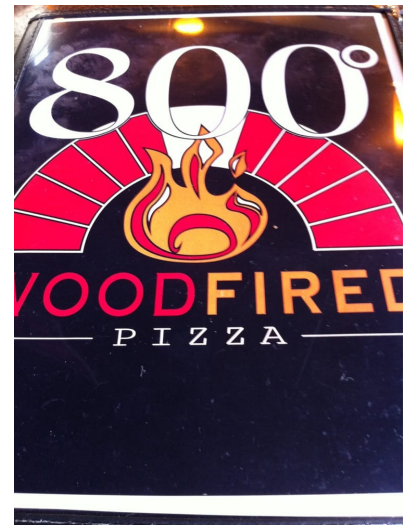
FROM THE EDITOR'S DESK

Remember, keep your skis between you and the slope: otherwise it can hurt!

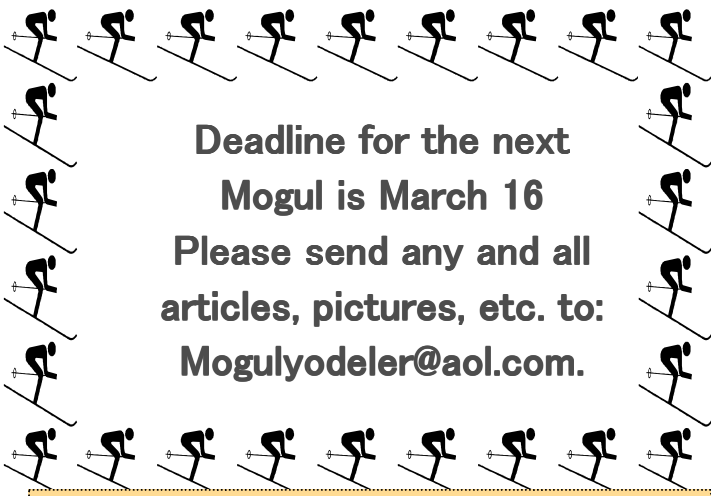


