

Biking season is off to a great start with 6–7 riders joining the first few rides—join Michael on the next one if you can!


Our Euchre Party had 21 players and was a big success—great food, fun games, and a huge thanks to Michelle for hosting!

Tennis is back too! See the schedule below if you'd like to join. We play every Wednesday night (weather permitting) through October.












Summer tennis started May 28 at




